Part-time Therapist/Counselor

Lamp Community is looking for a talented professional to join our Wellness Clinical Staff. Ideal candidate will provide:

- individual and group counseling services to Lamp Community members;
- complete biopsychosocial assessments;
- evaluations of the needs of members and develop care plans according to their needs and goals;
- and develop effective, trusting relationships with members, with a focus on facilitating independence and maintenance of improved physical and mental health.

The Part-time Therapist/Counselor will document meetings with members according to DMH and MediCal standards, assist in providing clinical information and support to staff members in Lamp's programs and work cooperatively and cohesively with other members of the multidisciplinary team, including participation in weekly staff meetings and staff trainings. Incumbent will ensure that mental health services are reflective of Lamp's model, which emphasizes customer choice, harm reduction and psycho-social rehabilitation.

Requirements/Qualifications:

MSW, LCSW or MFT. Supervision hours are available for this position. Minimum 2 years related post-graduate experience. Candidate must have experience working with persons who are homeless, have a mental illness and substance use issues. Candidate must demonstrate outstanding clinical, strong team-building, inter-personal and organizational skills.
